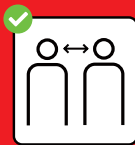


# Avoid infection in the museum

So that all guests have a pleasant stay with us, please note the following guidelines:

- ▷ We are sorry but **acutely ill persons** are not allowed to visit our museum!
- ▷ Please follow the **recommendations** of the Robert Koch Institute (RKI):

hands



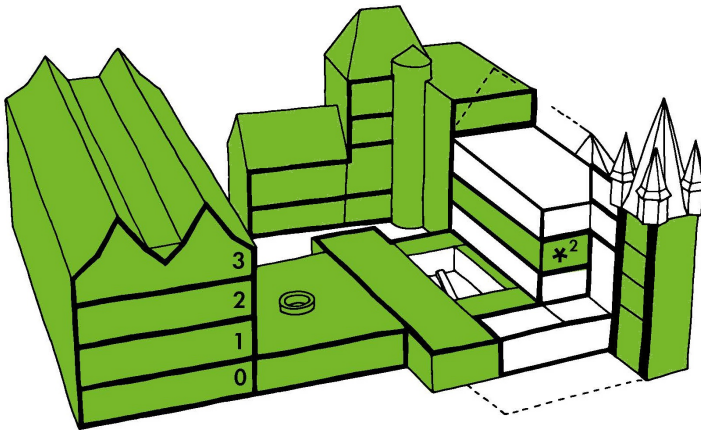
Cough and sneeze

- ▷ Please wear a **mouth-nose mask** (FFP2, KN95 (without valve), surgical mask, type I, II and IIR).
- ▷ In the staircases the **walking directions** are marked. Please follow these guidelines.
- ▷ If you need to use an **elevator**, follow the instructions given there.
- ▷ For a tour through the exhibition, you can use the **marks on the floor (guidance system for the blind)** to orientate yourself, so keep the direction in the exhibition.

- ▷ Open **doors and electronic door openers** as contactless as possible. If you need help, the public attendants and guards on all levels of the exhibition building will help you.
- ▷ If you touch **handrails, handles or buttons on showcases**, please use a handkerchief or your clothing sleeve.
- ▷ **Media stations** have been configured so that they do not need to be operated. At a few stations you can operate the touch surface yourself, they are regularly disinfected.
- ▷ If you need help or have any questions, please contact the **public attendants and guards**.
